09.02.15 Lark Energy - Solar Farm

Phase one is now complete and fully working. Phase Two – West Side – will start in the next few weeks.

The monies from Lark Energy have now been received - £10,000. The Solar Panels are on the Village Hall and Scout Hut which have been connected but there is no tariff as yet.

The Parish Council will be responsible for the maintenance of them and receive monies from the tariff's which will be ring fenced for village projects only.

10.02.15 Speed Warning Signs

Currently awaiting an appointment date for the signs being fitted. The Council will be updated on this later in the month.

11.02.15 Neighbourhood Plan – update

A Strategic Environment Assessment (SEA) may be needed (the cost of which is unknown at this time).

If this is required, West Lindsey DC will undertake a consultation with various statutory agencies for a period of 28 days. Once completed the SEA will have to be completed by the PC.

If an SEA is not required The Neighbourhood Plan (NP) will need to be checked by external body to ensure all is correct and legal.

We, the Parish council will then have to take it back to the people of Fiskerton by a Public Meeting to advise of the final draft before handing over to WLDC to take it onto Regulation 16 and hold a referendum for the public within the parish to vote to accept or reject the completed plan.

A further meeting of the NP committee has been held and they are progressing on the amendments required on drafts 3 and 4

12.02.15 Planning Matters

None were received.

It was proposed by Cllr A.Cooke and seconded by Cllr R.Wall that a planning committee be put back in place for the Council.

The Clerk is to create a Planning Policy for this and circulate as soon as possible.

13.02.15 Correspondence

A letter had been received for the renewal of the Council Insurance. As this was not currently listed under the payment section, it was proposed by Cllr A.Cooke and seconded by Cllr R.Wall that this payment be accepted and a cheque signed.

14.02.15 To receive the observations of the District and County Councillors

Cllr C.Darcel:

An extra meeting had been called at Hawthorn Road for an enquiry and there was approximately 250 people in attendance. Some of the people there accused the County Council of lying. He reported that he has written to Mr McArdle to state that another enquiry was not needed.
