1.0	Purpose of the Meeting	
1.1	<p>At their meeting on 5 December 2016 the parish council received a lengthy e-mail from Councillor Darcel relating to the Fiskerton Neighbourhood Plan.</p> <p>The meeting resolved to hold a special meeting to discuss the content of the e-mail and other issues related the neighbourhood plan in order to iron out some of the conflicts that exist and promote improved understanding.</p>	
2.0	Discussion Points	
2.1	<p>Councillor Wall tabled a series of questions to Councillor Darcel</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Q; Have you e-mail or other evidence from the Church Commission (CC) to support the comments published in the Fiskerton News (FN) and what was the plan “A” as referred to in the article? A; CD referred to an e-mail he received from John Weir dated 28/9/15 which stated no preference for a N/S or E/W orientation for development to the north east of Fiskerton. <p>AC noted that the FN article implied development to the West of Fiskerton which was misleading. CD made no apology for this.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A leaflet distributed by CD in July 2016 said; that in 2014; 67 out of 70 residents supported a plan similar to plan E when in fact 67 out of 70 voted by a show of hands to support the draft plan for 200 homes north of Corn Close. In the same leaflet Mr Strawson is asking for ‘the whole truth’ CD was asked to suggest what truth was missing at the time when it was clear a draft plan for 200 homes was discussed prior to December 2014. CD agreed it was and said alternative plans that indicated around 90 homes plus public facilities to the north and west of corn close were a draft and if required more homes could be accommodated in the available space. <p>RW explained that the option for development to the west of Fiskerton was raised with the CC who stated ‘land to the west was not available for development. RW to provide CD with a copy of the e-mail. Later the CC changed their mind and indicated land for development to the west is now an option.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> CD was asked what plan version he preferred.
