

## VICAR'S BLOG :

Its amazing how in a relatively short period of time, technology has moved on. I used to use a paper road map to get around and find my way on long journeys, now I have a satnav, the voice of which, with great authority, tells me when to turn right and left, and when I make a mistakes, tells me in no uncertain turns that it needs to re-calculate my route! These things are probably a blessing in disguise – they can be both irritating and wonderfully helpful.

A couple of years ago I was in the Lake District, had gone off on my own for a while and was later due to meet some friends in another part of the Lakes. I programmed my satnav – I don't know if this happens on other versions, but mine gives me an option of three routes – the fastest, the shortest and the ecological route. I chose the **shortest**. I don't know why, I rarely do this because timewise it usually takes longer but does less miles. Anyway, I set out .... The road was fine to start with, but as I took this turn and that, following the insistent voice, the road became narrower and narrower. I suppose I should have turned back, used my head and realised that maybe this wasn't the best option, but pig headedly I carried on, down tracks with grass growing down the middle. Until I came to a closed five-barred gate, on which was a notice that said 'DO NOT FOLLOW YOUR SATNAV'! Clearly I was not the only one that had blindly followed the voice! There was nowhere to turn around and it took half a mile of backing down the road to find somewhere to turn the car, face it the right way and move on..... embarrassed and hoping that no-one had witnessed this debacle!!

We are still in the season of Lent. Lent teaches us that there are no short cuts and no quick fixes in our walk with God. In Lent we remember that Jesus was led into the desert by the Holy Spirit, and was there for 40 days and nights. He suffered hardship and testing, but He was led there for a purpose – He was being formed and tested ready for three years of challenging ministry that would end with the suffering of Holy Week and the victory of Easter. If this was necessary for the Son of God, how necessary is it for all of us to come aside and let God do His work of transformation in us. There is no quick fix – God calls us aside and we will always be a work in progress!

#### **Four things, just for a change.**

I have just bought a new phone/internet package including a new windows smart phone, with which I should be able to fly. I should in theory be able to do to be much better connected and even run my business through my phone. But I am so pleased I bought the package from my computer guru George, here in the village. Not that there were problems, but had I bought from a remote vendor my stress levels would have risen to breaking point.

This brings me on to the more serious issue of the more vulnerable members in our community.

**Domestic Abuse.** On a training course on "Safeguarding Children & young People, & Adults at Risk" last night I was told it is a far bigger problem in West Lindsey than I ever realised. It could be you know someone who is elderly or disabled who is at risk from unintentional self-inflicted harm. It might be they are infirm and smoke and a dropped cigarette could prove fatal. Perhaps there is a trip hazard in their home that could be removed or it could be you know a child who is not being treated properly or an adult who is abused. Whatever the reason, there is a team of professional, confidential helpers at West Lindsey in place to help. Known as "safeguarding officers", they have a track record of helping those exposed to some of the less desirable aspects of life and can be reached on **01427 675199**. I have been lucky in life but the numbers are frightening and even in a small community such as ours, there could easily be several individuals who could do with support from the team.

Why not pass on the message or call the team direct.

#### **Straight from the WLDC press office-Assisted Move Scheme is hailed a 'godsend'**

It's all smiles for a couple who have moved into their new home after taking part in a new pilot project. The new Fiskerton residents were living in a house in Bardney which was too big for their needs and described the Assisted Move Scheme as a 'godsend'. West Lindsey District Council helped the couple make the move to ground floor accommodation in Fiskerton, provided by their landlord Acis Group. The Assisted Move Scheme covered the costs of a weekend's van hire, which allowed couple to change from a house to a bungalow. Team Manager of Housing and Communities at the council, Andy Gray, (tel 01427 675159) was "delighted that the pilot scheme was able to help someone so quickly".

While I am delighted for this couple I suspect there are others in the village who would also like to downsize. I can't promise to be of any help, but if you have housing problems why not contact me and I will see what I can find out for you.

**The Hawthorn Road closure.** It could still be several weeks before we know the outcome of the inquiry, but I find the mystery of who knew what and when quite baffling. At the Inquiry the Mr Randal, QC, stated that Nettleham Parish Council approved the closure. I can only guess he was misinformed, as two people I have spoken to involved with Nettleham Parish Council were not consulted. I would like to see the statements made by LCC at the Inquiry properly tested.

**Lastly a date for the diary. Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May:** a meeting in the Village hall to lay the foundations for a "Fiskerton Neighbourhood Plan" to give the Parish a legal framework in which it can define future developments in the village.
