
# Fiskerton Parish News

#### Vicar's Blog:

Yesterday I spent some time in church preaching about 'crossing boundaries'. My thinking had been stimulated by the account of Peter, in the book of Acts, who was at the centre of probably the most monumental event in the life of the early church. Peter a Jew 'crossed a boundary' by responding to the invitation of a Gentile, a non Jew, called Cornelius to tell him about Jesus. As a result Cornelius and his household came to faith. The issue for Peter was that as a Jew, visiting the house of a Gentile would have made him 'unclean'. Peter brought up in the Jewish faith, would have spent his whole life believing that and yet, because he was convicted by the Holy Spirit, he crossed the boundary and went. Peter risked a lot in this story including the hostility of his own people who believed that he crossed a boundary that should never have been crossed (the account of this comes later in the book of Acts).

That has made me think a lot. Crossing boundary lines is a difficult thing to do – it takes courage, it means stepping out – often alone, but Peter was able to do it because of the conviction of the Holy Spirit – for whilst this story is played out through people, the point of it is to describe to us how the purposes of God are accomplished in spite of the boundaries that we construct. Boundaries help us to reinforce our identities as people – they can also segregate, but the Holy Spirit has something else in mind. He is working a powerful transformation among early Christians, challenging their perceptions and their belief systems.

Wounds of exclusion run deep through our culture and frankly they run deep in the church; the realities of uncrossed boundaries still exist. The recent election has demonstrated and it will it take people of courage to cross boundaries that will bring about healing. The new Government, opposition, leaders in our society need our prayer as they face massive challenges to bring people together and set a healing tone.




