

Vicar's Blog:

Many of you will know that I am quite 'into' sport, hence Radio 5Live is my listening of choice. At the week-end, I was listening to an interview with Phil Neville, the former England Man Utd. and Everton footballer and now a football pundit. He was talking about his experience of Twitter and Social Media in general, commenting that as a footballer he had become used to abuse from all directions, but when the abuse began to be aimed at family, it crossed a line. He has a disabled daughter and when threats and comments 'tipped over the edge' he had on one occasion, referred the matter to the police who discovered that the threats were issued by teenagers, because they 'thought it was a laugh'. Clearly, 'having a laugh' over the airwaves is not the sole province of teenagers — adults have much the same capacity.

I am a fan of social media. I don't go overboard, but I think it's a useful tool and an instant way of communicating with people. It is probably here to stay until someone invents the 'next thing'. Many of our schools, with the right safeguards in place, use it really well to communicate what the children are doing, and if you want to know what's happening in the world, as it is happening, then social media is the place.

However, that interview with Phil Neville made me think about labels and anonymity. One of the things that happens when people 'troll' over the internet is that they fail to see the person behind the comment. So, they are anonymous and the person they are abusing is anonymous, so they become a 'label'. No feelings, no humanity, just something or someone to have a pop at – the person to person contact is gone. I suspect that in almost every case, the abuser wouldn't abuse if the person was sitting in front of them..... if I am honest, I am not certain this is the sole province of social media either. It is very easy to anonymize people by labeling them and by taking the person out of the role and therefore feel that it's ok to 'have a go'. I guess this is part of human behaviour – it happened in the day of Jesus and it happens in relation to Jesus now – people like to label him as a mildly interesting historical figure, or a teacher whose teachings impress because they give voice to the voiceless – but to believe that He is the Son of God and central to the human story attaches an importance that rather blows the labels out of the box.

Have you received scam mail through your door recently? The likelihood is that you probably have. Scam mail is sent by fraudsters, often from overseas, trying to persuade residents to part with money or personal information by tempting them with cash prizes. These scams can result in considerable financial loss to the victims.

Trading Standards have become aware of an incident where a resident was sent a scam letter enclosing a photograph of a cheque with the victim's name on it, claiming that they had won the Football Lottery. The victim was asked to post a considerable amount of cash in order for the cheque to be released. Not surprisingly, this was a scam and the victim lost the money.

These types of scams are often time limited which puts pressure on the potential victim to reply quickly. Once the letters are replied to the residents personal details are often added to a list of potential targets which are then circulated to other fraudsters. Residents who respond to scams can then be bombarded with similar scam mailings. Please keep an eye on vulnerable neighbours, family or friends to help present them becoming the targets of these types of scams.

Trading Standards advise you not to respond to any mailing which has the hallmarks of a scam and would encourage you to forward the letter to Royal Mail with a covering letter to:

You can also email Royal Mail at scam.mail@royalmail.com or report your concerns by calling 03456 113 413. We will send you a scam mail report form for completion together with a prepaid addressed envelope in which to return the form with examples of the scam mail received.

NETTLEHAM MEDICAL PRACTICE

MISSED APPOINTMENTS: The practice is continuing to experience a high number of appointments which patients do not attend (called "DNAs" for short). During April 2015, 11¾ hours of doctor time and 32 hours of nursing time were lost due to DNAs.

If you are unable to attend an appointment that you have booked, please contact the practice and cancel so that it can be given to someone else.

<u>ELECTRONIC TRANSFER OF PRESCRIPTIONS (ETP)</u> The practice successfully went 'live' with Electronic Prescriptions on 13th May 2015 (for more information please go to the ETP website - http://systems.hscic.gov.uk/eps). How this will affect patients with repeat prescriptions depends on several criteria so below is a summary of what it actually means for you:

- **Dispensing Patients nothing will change for you at all and you will continue to request and obtain medications just as you do now.
- **Non-Dispensing Patients If you have nominated a pharmacy, your prescription will be sent to them and you will be able to collect your medication in the usual way two working days later.
- **Non Dispensing Patients If you have not nominated a pharmacy, you will need to collect your signed prescription from one of the dispensaries and then take to a pharmacy of your choice. You can nominate a pharmacy of your choice at any time (and change the pharmacy) by letting the dispenser at the practice know who will update your records at the practice.
- **If you are issued an acute prescription, this may be sent via ETP but you will need to allow at least 2 hours for the prescription to be available to download at the pharmacy.


